

THE SENSE OF JUSTICE Markus Dirk Dubber Universal Law Publishers, 2012 (one copy)





In 1956 Mr. Iyer was elected initially to Madras Legislative Assembly and later, after reorganization of States, to the Kerala Assembly, where he was chosen as Minister in charge of Important portfolios like Home, Law, Social Welfare and Irrigation.
