- ❖ A study corner is also under consideration in the Old Judges Library for Hon'ble former Judges of this august Court in order to quench the thirst of study of their lordships.

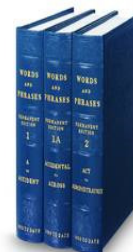
